## Paragon Cardmodels Alenia/Lockheed Martin C-27J



The Alenia C-27J is a medium transport capable of STOL (Short Take-Off and Landing) from undeveloped landing strips. The United States originally acquired 10 C-27As by purchasing 10 G.222 aircraft from Alenia and modifying them. They were retired from service in 1999. In 2007 Alenia, with Lockheed Martin began the distribution of the C-27J, an advanced version of the aircraft. The C-27J is fitted with many of the latest systems developed for the Lockheed Martin C-130J, including its Rolls-Royce engines, composite propellors, and avionics. The C-27J can sustain 3g tactical airlift operations, and is even capable of performing barrel rolls. It is currently operated by the United States, Italy, Romania, Lithuania, Greece and Bulgaria.
